### Synopsis of Meeting:

- Voting on the Historic Overlay District began at 6pm due to the conflict with the Maury open house.
- Voting Process: Members were checked against the member list and one ticket was given per household. Individuals were allowed to join at that time and vote. Individuals were asked to mark a “Y” for Yes on the ticket in support of the Historic Overlay District or “N” for No on the ticket against the Historic Overlay District. The Individual then placed the ticket in the Yes or No box.
- Meeting began at 7:30.
  - Each side was given five minutes to present their side of the issue. Rob Turner spoke against the Historic Overlay District. Mike O’Hearn spoke for the Historic Overlay District.
  - Additional announcement from Dave O’Dell:
    - The next meeting will be held on December 8, 2005 (second Thursday of the month). The two agenda items are:
      - A presentation by ODU on the status of their long-range plans including football.
      - Election of officers will be held. The president and vice-president will be stepping down so volunteers are needed. Please let Dave O’Dell know if you would like to run for any office.
    - The meeting was adjourned so individuals could vote.
